**Performance Test**

#### 1. Mental Stability



Measures driver's resilience. management, and emotional control, focusing on coping skills and behavioral responses to drivingrelated stress.



#### 2. Sense of Responsibility





Assesses a driver's accountability, awareness of consequences, and adherence to traffic laws, reflecting their commitment to safe and responsible driving practices.



#### 3. Self-Control







Evaluates impulse regulation, decision-making, and compliance with traffic regulations, especially in challenging or stressful driving situations.



#### 4. Non-Aggressive Behavior





Measures patience, courtesy, and cooperation with other road users, identifying tendencies to avoid aggressive or hostile driving behaviors.





#### 5. Embracing Tranquility



Assesses calmness and composure under traffic stress, revealing how drivers maintain tranquility and sound judgment while driving.



#### 6. Agreeableness





Evaluates a driver's cooperative nature, conflict avoidance, and trust toward others on the road to promote harmonious traffic interactions.



#### 7. Neuroticism







Measures anxiety, emotional instability, sensitivity to stress, showing how these factors influence driving behavior and risk perception.



#### 8. Environmental Concern







attitudes environmental Assesses toward sustainability in transportation and the level of engagement with eco-friendly driving choices.





#### 9. Risk Avoidance



Evaluates hazard awareness, strategic decisionmaking, and adherence to safety measures to encourage cautious and preventive driving behavior.



#### 10. Lapse





Measures susceptibility to attention memory errors, and impulsive decisions that can compromise safe driving performance.



#### 11. Violation







Assesses attitudes toward traffic rules and intentions to engage in rule-breaking behaviors while driving.



#### 12. Alcohol Risk







Evaluates attitudes, beliefs, and behaviors related to alcohol consumption and driving, focusing on risk awareness and control.
